AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Stefain-Ferguson to King County Water District No. 119.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Stefain-Ferguson to King County Water District No. 119 was filed with the County Council effective January 25, 1977.

2. King County Water District No. 119 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolutions 55 and 62, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 119 filed a Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance dated January 14, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1977, to consider the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 119 or the area known as Stefain-Ferguson and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Stefain-Ferguson to be annexed is described as follows:
