ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing condemnation of property for the Hermes Ponding and Drainage facility.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. The King County Council on November 24, 1976, by Ordinance No. 2988, and as amended, did adopt the 1977 Annual Budget for King County, and did provide therein for the Capital Budget and Program, which included a Housing and Community Development Program funded by Community Development Block Grant funds.
- 2. The King County Council on February 14, 1977, by Motion No. 2880 did adopt the 1977 Community Development Program and Housing Assistance Plan, and provided therein for an allocation of \$330,000.00 for acquisition and construction of the Hermes Ponding and Drainage facility.
- 3. In order to acquire the property and property rights required to lay out and construct the ponding and drainage facility on lands commonly known as Hermes Depression, it is necessary for King County to condemn certain lands and property rights and rights in property for public purposes as hereinafter more particularly set forth.
- 4. The King County Council finds that the public health, safety, necessity, convenience and welfare demand that the ponding and drainage facility be constructed in accordance with the Community Development Program and Housing Assistance Plan, and that certain properties, property rights and rights in property be condemned, appropriated, taken and damages for the construction of said ponding and drainage facility, as provided in this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Council has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of King County that the lands hereinafter described, and other property rights and/or rights in property be condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for the purpose of constructing the Hermes Ponding and Drainage facility, subject to the making or paying of just compensation to the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 2. The King County Council determines that condemnation proceedings are hereby authorized to acquire property and property rights and/or rights in property, for the purposes of subject ponding and drainage facility.

SECTION 3. The attorneys for King County are hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the proceedings provided by law to condemn, take and appropriate the land and other property and property rights necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.
