ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Forward Thrust Arterial Resolution No. 34569; finding certain projects to be completed; duly providing for the completion of certain projects; finding certain projects to be impractical to complete and therefore deleting said projects; adding additional projects; and repealing ordinances numbers 1016 and 1236.

PREAMBLE:

King County Resolution No. 34569 (hereinafter "Resolution") was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners (now the King County Council and the King County Executive) on December 18, 1967 and is commonly referred to as the Forward Thrust Arterial Highway Improvement Bond Resolution.

This Resolution was approved by the voters of King County on the 13th day of February, 1968. The voters authorized the issuance of general obligation bonds for the purpose of improving existing public arterial highway facilities or constructing new public arterial highway facilities all within. King County by the various cities, towns and King County.

Arterial highway facilities as contemplated by the Resolution and defined therein mean public roads lawfully designated as arterials by the state of Washington and other appropriate governmental agencies.

Projects described in Section 3 of the Resolution assigned to the County were based in whole or in part upon street and highway plans as then approved by the Washington State Highway Commission and Puget Sound Governmental Conference, such as the Green River Valley Transportation Plan prepared in July, 1967 for the Washington State Highway Commission; and

the Major Streets and Highways Plan in King County, prepared in 1967 by King County.

The Resolution authorized King County to improve or construct 134 existing or new arterials in the county. To date, 100 of those projects have been completed, are in progress or their completion duly provided for.

King County will have sufficient funds from the Resolution bond proceeds, interest earned on such bond proceeds, supplemental matching funds, federal funding or County Road Fund allocation to duly provide for the completion of all arterial road projects to be constructed by King County which are described in paragraph EE of Section 3 of the Resolution (hereinafter "Projects") and which the King County legislative authority (as intended by the Resolution) finds to be practical of accomplishment within the contemplation of the Resolution.

Section 5 of the Resolution provides in part that if the King County legislative authority (hereinafter "Legislative Authority") shall determine that conditions occurred which make it impractical to substantially accomplish any of the Projects by reason of prior incompatible development, cost substantially in excess of the amount of bond proceeds estimated to be applied thereto, prior acquisition by a superior governmental authority or other changed conditions, King County shall not be required to accomplish such Project and may apply such funds as provided in Section 6 of the Resolution. The Legislative Authority desires to specify those Projects which are impractical to complete as contemplated by the Resolution.

The creation of the Urban Arterial Board (Chapter 47.26 Revised Code of Washington); the revision by the

State Highway Commission of planned state freeways (Chapter 47.01 Revised Code of Washington); the adoption by King County voters in 1972 of a comprehensive county-wide transit plan operated by the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (Chapter 35.5 Revised Code of Washington); the review and adoption of regional transportation plans by the Puget Sound Governmental Conference (Chapter 35.63 Revised Code of Washington); and the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act (hereinafter "SEPA") and the requirement to prepare an environmental impact report before highway construction (Chapters 43.21C and 47.04 Revised Code of Washington respectively) resulted in changed conditions after the passage of the Resolution which required review of certain Projects.

Bond proceeds in addition to those required for the construction of those Projects which were deemed practical of accomplishment, have been available for additional arterial improvements contemplated by the Resolution. The Legislative Authority now desires to specify, ratify and approve the additional projects eligible to be funded from such bond proceeds.
