AN ORDINANCE relating to solid waste operations establishing service fees therefore; amending Ordinance No. 2801, Section 1, 1976; Ordinance No. 1985, Section 1, 1974; Ordinance No. 800, Section 2, 1971; and, King County Code 10.12.020.

## PREAMBLE:

The King County Executive and King County Council, as authorized by the King County Charter, have determined that the Solid Waste Operating Fund shall be self-supporting through service fees charged various classes of customers for use of county-operated disposal facilities.

The existing service fees charged various classes of customers for use of county-operated disposal facilities are not adequate to recover the cost of operating such facilities.

The existing service fees charged various classes of customers for use of the county-operated transfer stations are expressed in terms of volume; whereas, the installation of scales at county-operated transfer stations would require transfer station service fees to be expressed in terms of weight.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2801, Section 1, 1976; Ordinance 1985, Section 1, 1974; Ordinance 800, Section 2, 1971; and, King County Code 10.12.020 are hereby amended as follows:

All persons using county-operated solid waste ((final)) disposal facilities shall pay the service fees set forth in the following schedule:
