ORDINANCE NO. 3323

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Baarslag to King County Water District No. 124.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. King County Water District No. 124 filed a May 31, 1977, Notice of Intention indicating a petition for annexation of 20 acres of land was sufficient, containing signatures of 60% of the land owners, and by Resolution 193 concurred with the proposed annexation. The District filed a Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance on the proposed annexation. The District has a County approved comprehensive plan as required in Ordinance No. 1709, as amended.

2. The Boundary Review Board has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 36.39.170 and has found that the proposed annexation adequately meets the objectives enumerated in RCW 36.93.180.

3. The King County Council held a public hearing on the 18th day of July, 1977, has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060 and has found the proposed annexation to be adequately consistent with such criteria and to be in the public interest.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 124 of the area known as Baarslag and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
