ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 77-14 - Weyerhaeuser to King County Water District No. 124.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as 77-14 Weyerhaeuser to King County Water District No. 124 was filed with the County Council effective June 29, 1977.
- 2. King County Water District No. 124 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 194, concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. King County Water District No. 124 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated May 17, 1977, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the \$172 day of Green , 1977, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 124 of the area known as 77-14 - Weyerhaeuser and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
