ORDINANCE NO. 3340

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 77-7 to King County Water District No. 124.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as 77-7 to King County Water District No. 124 was filed with the County Council effective June 29, 1977.

2. King County Water District No. 124 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 198, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 124 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated May 31, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 15th day of August, 1977, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 124 of the area known as 77-7 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as 77-7 to be annexed is described as follows:
