## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of an area known as Wagar from King County Water District No. 56.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of an area known as Wagar from King County Water District No. 56 was filed with the County Council effective July 8, 1977.
- 2. King County Water District No. 56 has found the petition for withdrawal to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 223, concurred with the proposed withdrawal.
- 3. King County Water District No. 56 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated June 13, 1977, on the proposed withdrawal.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 15th day of August, 1977, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal by King County Water District No. 56 of the area known as Wagar and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
