ORDINANCE NO. 3367

AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Capital Budget and Program, accelerating \$20,000 from the Snoqualmie Valley Community Allocation Project in the 1978 Capital Improvement Program, transferring it to and creating a 1977 Capital Improvement Program Project known as Fall City Schoolyard Improvements, increasing the 1977 Capital Improvement Budget and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 68, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer and acceleration of funds in the amount of \$20,000 from the Snoqualmie Valley Community Allocation Project No. 007076 in the 1978 Capital Improvement Program to and creating a 1977 Capital Improvement Program Project, Fall City Schoolyard Improvements for the improvement of two school sites at Fall City.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 68, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 68, Attachment No. 1 as amended, is hereby revised as depicted on the attached Capital Budget Resource pages.

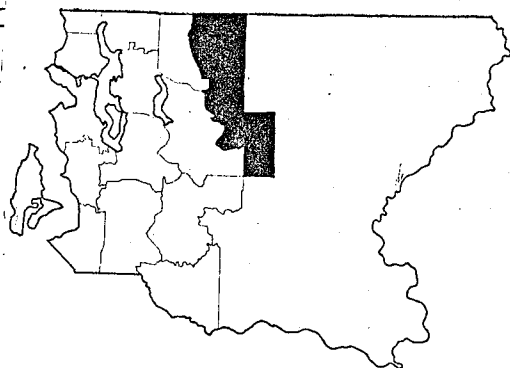
