ORDINANCE NO. 3389

AN ORDINANCE relating to the parking of vehicles in bus zones and the signing and marking of bus zones and adding a new section to King County Ordinance 1100 and K.C.C. Title 46.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

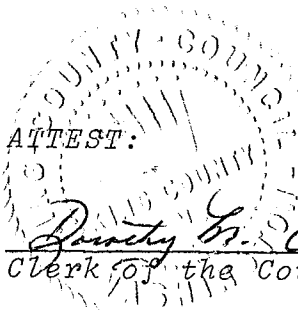
NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. Whenever a portion of the street along the curb or edge of roadway is designated by a sign with the words "BUS" and a parking control message or red-yellow-red (alternating red and yellow stripes) curb markings, such area shall be reserved for the loading and unloading of Metro Transit coaches. No person shall stop, stand, park or angle park any other vehicle in a bus zone designated as such, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a peace officer.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 8th day of August, 1977.
