8 ORDINANCE NO. 3393

9 AN ORDINANCE relating to drainage plans, re-
10 quiring that drainage plans be prepared by
11 registered civil engineers; and amending
12 Ordinance 2281, Section 3., Ordinance 2812,
13 Section 1., and K.C.C. 20.50.030.

12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

13 SECTION 1. Ordinance 2281, Section 3, Ordinance 2812,
14 Section 1, and K.C.C. 20.50.030, are each amended to read as
15 follows:

16 Drainage Plan - Submission. (a) ~~((All persons applying))~~
17 Applications for any of the following permits and/or approvals
18 shall ~~((submit for approval))~~ be accompanied by a drainage plan
19 ~~((with their application and/or request))~~ which has been pre-
20 pared by a registered civil engineer:

- 21 (1) Grading permit;
- 22 (2) Substantial development permit;
- 23 (3) Flood control zone permit;
- 24 (4) Subdivision approval;
- 25 (5) Unclassified use permits;
- 26 (6) Conditional use permits;
- 27 (7) Building permits where the permit relates to five
28 thousand or more square feet of development coverage within the
29 property;
- 30 (8) Planned unit development.

31 (b) Drainage plans prepared by a registered civil engineer will

1 be required for those short plat applications which present
2 adverse drainage impacts as defined by administrative guidelines
3 to be developed by the department and the Division of Building
4 and Land Development and approved by the County Council.

5 (c) The plan submitted during one permit/approval process
6 may be subsequently submitted with further required applications.
7 The plan shall be supplemented with additional information at
8 the request of the department. The plan requirement establish-
9 ed in this section will not apply when the department determines
10 that the proposed permit and/or activity:

11 (1) Will not seriously and adversely impact the water
12 quality conditions of any affected receiving bodies of water;
13 and/or

14 (2) Will not alter the drainage patterns, increase the
15 peak discharge, and cause any other adverse effects in the
16 drainage area.
