ORDINANCE NO. 3395

AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, removing the one way travel restriction on 90th Avenue Northeast between Northeast 134th Street and Northeast 136th Street, and amending King County Ordinance 1100, Schedule 10.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, and as authorized by King County Traffic Code 46.61.135 adopting RCW 46.61.135, Schedule 10 which establishes one way travel on county roads is amended to delete the following location:

90TH AVENUE NORTHEAST, between Northeast 134th Street and Northeast 136th Street, travel is established in a southerly direction only on the westerly roadway section and in a northerly direction only on the easterly roadway section.

SECTION 2. Signs to evidence the above described restriction shall be removed by the proper authority.
