ORDINANCE NO. 3429

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of Marine View Drive Petitioner - Norma E. Gepford

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. Motion No. 2706 has been passed authorizing the preparation of an ordinance requesting vacation of a portion of Marine View Drive, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the proposed vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and were advised that easements are not required.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of Marine View Drive established on May 2, 1966, and a Quit Claim Deed for a portion of the area described herein is recorded in Volume 4965 of Deeds, page 268. A search by the Department of Public Works indicates that in 1967, \$2,540.00 was paid to T.M. and Norma E. Gepford for the right of way over their property. A search of the records indicate that the County has spent no funds for construction or maintenance of this vacation area.
- 5. In accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759, the right of way would be classified "A Class." King County is now in receipt of \$1,350.00 from Norma E. Gepford, which has been judged to be the just compensation to King County for the vacation area.
- 6. The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believe that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 2671 day of September, 1977.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KING: SECTION 1. The Council on the 26th day of Systemher, 1977,

hereby vacates and abandons the portion of Marine View Drive, described as follows:

> That portion of Marine View Drive South, described as follows: That parcel of land deeded to King County for a public road and recorded in Volume 4965 of Deeds, page 268, EXCEPT that portion lying northwesterly of the arc of a circle having a radius of 125.00 feet and which is tangent to a line 30 feet southerly of and parallel with the north line of Section 32, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., and tangent to the easterly right of way margin of W.A. Hall Road as shown on King County Survey No. 1370.
