AN ORDINANCE relating to the Vacation of a Portion of 130th Avenue N.E.

Petitioner: Mac-Rent, Inc., and others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 130th Avenue N.E., hereinafter described.
- 2. The report of the Department of Public Works and Transportation and the Building and Land Development Division, finds that the portion of 130th Avenue N.E. to be vacated is useless to the county and the vacation would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of the proposed vacation.
- The various utilities serving the area have been notified and we are advised that easements have been secured by Puget Sound Power and Light Company and King County Water District No. 104.
- The petition requested that the vacated area be north of Bear Creek. The Department of Public Works has revised the description to include the culvert under which Bear Creek flows.
- 5. The vacation area is a portion of all that remains of Woodin Way Relocation Road (County Survey No. 2469) which was established by King County on April 2, 1928. It was a maintained asphalt concrete road. A wooden bridge which connected the subject road with Cascade Avenue on the south side of Bear Creek within the plat of Richbottom (Volume 25, Page 3) was also maintained and in 1965 replaced by a culvert. We therefore, classify the right-of-way "B Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 6. In accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759, the area to be vacated was appraised by the Real Property Division Appraisal staff and the fair market value for the 12,000 square feet to be vacated amounts to \$5,580, which amount the petitioners have agreed to submit to the King County Comptroller.

Due Notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 26th day of September, 19 //

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
