ORDINANCE NO. 3450

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$954,900 to the Grant Fund from a Retroactive Referendum 26 Grant award for centralized grant accounting purposes and substituting this revenue source for County Bond Sale proceeds previously appropriated to the Solid Waste Scale System C.I.P. Project No. 003019; amending and revising the 1977 Solid Waste Scale System C.I.P. Project No. 003019; amending and revising the 1977 Solid Waste Capital Improvement Budget and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, attachment no. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$954,900 to the Grant Fund from a retroactive Washington State Department of Ecology Referendum 26 Grant Award No. 263361024, County File No. 670:3, for centralized grant accounting purposes.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted the substitution of a retroactive Referendum 26 Grant Award revenue source in the amount of \$954,900 for County Bond Sale proceeds previously appropriated to the Solid Waste Capital Fund for the Solid Waste Scale System C.I.P. Project No. 003019; amending and revision the 1977 Solid Waste Capital Improvement Budget as depicted on the attached project information sheet and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, attachment No. 1, as amended.
