ORDINANCE NO. 3454

AN ORDINANCE relating to business licenses and regulations, prohibiting the location within two thousand feet of a religious or educational institution any public place which offers topless dancing, and amending Chapter 6.08 of the King County Code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. Under the provisions of KCC 6.08, no Amusement Place License shall be issued to any firm or individual that proposes to offer topless dancing, such dancing within the definitions provided in KCC 6.08, if such premises will be located within two thousand feet of the premises of any church, parochial or tax supported public elementary or secondary school measured along the most direct route over or across established public walks, streets or other public passageway from the outer property line of the church or school grounds to the nearest public entrance of the premises proposed for license; PROVIDED THAT, for the purposes of definition a church shall mean a building erected for and used exclusively for religious worship and schooling or other activity in connection therewith.
