ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Suburban Estate zone classification; changing existing definitions and adding new definitions; permitting public stables and certain agricultural uses; eliminating "pasture and grazing" as a listed permitted use; amending Resolution 25789, Sections 272, 199.12, 299.13 and 901, and KCC 21.04.390, 21.04.595 and 21.04.600; adding a new section to KCC 21.04; amending Ordinance 1013, Sections 7 and 8, Resolution 33159 (part), and KCC 21.18.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Resolution 25789, Section 272, and KCC 21.04.390 are amended to read as follows:

"Livestock" means horses, bovine animals, sheep, goats, swine, reindeer, donkeys and mules (+++), but does not include confinement of such animals in feedlots or stockyards for final finishing prior to slaughter.

SECTION 2. Resolution 25789, Section 299.12, and KCC 21.04.595 are amended to read as follows:

"Private stable" means a detached accessory building in which horses or other beasts of burden ({owned-by-the-occupants of-the-premises}) are kept, and in which no ({animals}) horses are kept for hire ({7-remuneration-or-sale}).

SECTION 3. Resolution 25789, Section 299.13, and KCC 21.04.600 are amended to read as follows:

"Public stable" means a ({stable-other-than-a-private} stable) building or group of buildings in which horses or other beasts of burden are kept for commercial boarding, training, riding lessons, breeding or auction, which does not have a riding arena of more than ten thousand square feet, and in which no horses are kept for hire. Establishments with larger arenas are considered "commercial recreation areas" as defined in this chapter.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 4. The following section is added to KCC 21.04:

Stable, rental. "Rental stable" means a public stable in

which horses or other beasts of burden are kept for hire as well as boarding, training, riding lessons or breeding.

SECTION 5. Ordinance 1013, Sections 7 and 8, Resolution 33159 (part), Resolution 25789, Section 901, and KCC 21.18.020 are each amended to read as follows:

In an S-E zone the following uses only are permitted and as hereinafter specifically provided and allowed by this chapter, subject to the off-street parking requirements and the general provisions and exceptions set forth in this title beginning with Chapter 21.46.

- (1) Any use permitted in the RS classification under the same conditions set forth in such classification, except that the lot area, yard and open space requirements set forth in this classification shall apply;
- (2) Agricultural crops, provided no retail sales of products are permitted on the premises for parcels of less than five acres;
 - (3) Accessory buildings and uses, including the following:
- (a) Private stables, provided such buildings or structures shall not be located closer than thirty-five feet to any boundary property line or closer than forty-five feet to any building containing a dwelling unit or accessory living quarters on the same premises and provided further that there shall be no open-air storage of manure, hay, straw, shavings or similar organic materials closer than thirty-five feet to any property boundary line or closer than forty-five feet to any dwelling unit or accessory living quarters on the same premises;
- (b) Greenhouses (\(\frac{\for-propagation-and-culture-only-and}{no}\), provided no retail sales (\(\frac{\fraccc}\frac{\frac{\frac{\frac{\frac}\frac{\frac{\frac{\frac{\frac{\frac{\
- (c) Marketing of products produced on-site, provided the site is five acres or larger, and only one stand to be used for such purposes, and such stand shall not have more than three hundred square feet of floor area, and shall not be located in

any required yard or open space;

- (4) Day nurseries, provided:
- (a) If conducted as an accessory use to a dwelling and no more than six children are cared for at one time, or
- (b) If conducted as a nursery school on the same site with a public or private school or church;
- (5) Day nurseries subject to the issuance of a conditional use permit provided the following minimum conditions are met:
- (a) The building site contains a minimum of thirty-five thousand square feet and at least two hundred square feet of site area for each child cared for,
- (b) No more than fifty children are cared for at one time,
- (c) Buildings, structures and play equipment areas shall not be closer than thirty feet to any property line,
- (d) Any play area is completely enclosed by a solid wall or fence not less than five feet nor more than six feet in height,
- (e) A minimum of three off-street parking spaces plus one for each employee is provided,
- (f) One stationary, non-flashing sign not exceeding sixteen square feet in area shall be permitted,
- (g) Building design, site plans and landscaping shall be of a character which is appropriate for the area;
- (6) Livestock, but not including swine (\(\frac{1}{2}\)erestable the occupants-of-the-premises-only;)) provided:
- (a) Not more than one such animal, excluding sucklings, for each one-half acre of the total site area shall be permitted except there shall be no limit on horses kept in a public stable;
- (b) Fee boarding of others' livestock shall be accessory to a residence on the subject property and the total number of animals, including those owned by the occupants of the premises shall not exceed one animal for each one-half acre of the site;

 (c) Any building, pen or structure used to house, confine or feed such animals shall not be located closer than seventy-five feet and in the case of goats no closer than one hundred fifty feet to any boundary property line nor closer than forty-five to any building containing a dwelling unit or accessory living quarters on the same premises;

(7) ({Pasture-and-grazing-but-net-including-feed-lets provided:

Where-such-pasture-or-grazing-area-abuts-on-any-property-line
which-is-a-common-property-line-with-"R"-classified-property, there
shall-be-erected-and-maintained-on-such-common-property-line-a
fence-not-less-than-five-feet-nor-more-than-six-feet-in-height.)

Public stables, on a minimum of ten acres, provided:

- (a) Any stable, arena, or barn shall be located no closer than seventy-five feet to any boundary property line or closer than forty-five feet to any building containing a dwelling unit on the same premises (However, one barn or stable building may contain a caretaker's accessory living quarters);
- (b) Any corrals or exercise yards shall maintain a distance of not less than thirty-five feet from any building containing a dwelling unit or accessory living quarters on the same premises;
- (c) There shall be no open-air storage of manure, hay, straw, shavings or similar organic material closer than thirty-five feet to any property line or closer than forty-five feet to any dwelling unit or accessory living quarters;
- (d) When a parking area is located adjacent to any property line, a ten foot strip adjacent to such property line shall be landscaped with evergreen shrubs, bushes or trees, which shall be maintained at a height of not less than five feet. Said landscaping shall be planted according to accepted practice and maintained in good condition at all times. Existing vegetation on the site may be used to help meet this requirement, provided that

- (e) Any outside area lighting shall be installed in such a way as to prevent glare from affecting adjacent streets and residences;
- (f) One unlighted sign, up to sixteen square feet in size, shall be permitted;
- (8) Raising of <u>poultry</u>, chicken, squab and rabbits ({for-use of-the-occupants-of-the-premises-only}), provided:
- (a) No more than thirty ({of-any-one-combination})

 <u>in total of</u> such fowl or animals <u>per acre</u> may be kept on the premises;
- (b) Any birds kept on the premises shall be confined within an aviary;
- (c) Any building, pen, aviary or structure used to house or contain such fowl and animals shall not be located closer than thirty-five feet to any boundary property line of the premises, or closer than forty-five feet to any building containing a dwelling unit or accessory living quarters on the same premises;
- (9) Raising of hamsters, nutria and chinchilla for commercial purposes, provided:
- (a) No more than one hundred (\(\frac{\text{hamsters}_{\text{-or-one}}}{\text{hundred-ehinehillas}_{\text{-or-one-hundred-of-such-animals-in-combination}_{\text{tion}_{\text{-}}}) of such animals per acre may be kept on the premises;

- Any buildings, pens, cages or structures used to contain or house such animals shall not be located closer than thirty-five feet to any boundary property line of the premises, or closer than forty-five feet to any building containing a dwelling unit or accessory living quarters on the same premises; (10) Signs, as follows:
- One unlighted identification sign not exceeding two square feet in area containing the name of the occupant of the premises,
- One unlighted double-faced sign not exceeding six (b) square feet of area per face, pertaining only to the sale, lease or hire of only the particular building, property or premises upon which displayed;
- (11) Any other use permitted in an "A" zone and subject to the same restrictions, provided that the subject property must be at least ten acres in size, and may not be subdivided if the subdivision will result in the use being on a site under ten acres in size, and excluding the following uses:

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1	(a) Food processing plants and facilities, and feed,

4	(c) Housing facilities to accomodate agricultural
