## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Park Place/Decatur Glen to Lakehaven Sewer District.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Park Place/Decatur Glen was filed with the County Council effective October 4, 1977.
- 2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 76-506, concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated August 18, 1977, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 31st day of October, 1977, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as Park Place/Decatur Glen and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Park Place/Decatur Glen to be annexed is described as follows:

The West half of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 12, Township 21 North, Range 3 East, W.M. in King County, Washington except that portion which is platted Country Village No. 3 as recorded in Volume 79 of Plats, pages 53 and 54, records of King County, Washington County, Washington.
