 AN ORDINANCE authorizing condemnation of sanitary sewer easements for the Renton Maintenence Facility.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. The King County Council on November 24, 1976, by Ordinance No. 2988, and as amended, did adopt the 1977 Annual Budget for King County, and did provide therein for the Capital Budget and Program, which included a Public Works Capital Improvement Program.
- 2. The Capital Budget and Program provides for the development of a consolidated and maintenance repair facility at Renton for the Department of Public Works Road Division, vehicle maintenance operations and office space to be utilized by Hydraulics Division and Roads Division.
- 3. In order to acquire the property and property rights required to lay out and construct the Renton Maintenance Facility it is necessary for King County to condemn certain lands and property rights and rights in property for public purposes as hereinafter more particularly set forth.
- 4. The King County Council finds that the public health, safety, necessity, convenience and welfare demand that a sanitary sewer system be constructed in order to develop the Renton Maintenance Facility in accordance with the King County Capital Budget and Program, and that certain properties, property rights and rights in property be condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for the construction of said facility, as provided in this ordinance,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Council has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of King County that the lands hereinafter described, and other property rights and/or rights in property be condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for the purpose of constructing the sanitary sewer system for the Renton Maintenance Facility, subject to the making or paying of just compensation to the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT

A parcel of land in Government Lot 6, in Section 16,

Township 23 North, Range 5 East, W.M., lying North of 1 Block 4 of the Plat of Maplewood Division No. 2, as 2 recorded in Volume 39 of Plats, page 39, records of King County, Washington; said parcel being the East 3 10 feet of that portion of said Government Lot 6 lying Westerly of and adjacent to the Easterly line of Lot 2 of said Block 4 produced Northerly. Together with a Temporary Construction Easement. SECTION 2.
