ORDINANCE NO. 3502

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 51st Place South V-1539 Petitioner: Gary D. Holzhauer and others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 51st Place South, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and were advised that an easement has been obtained by Puget Sound Power and Light Company.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of two established roads: Orillia Road Extension, Survey No. 35-23-4-3, established on January 30, 1933, and a portion of Orillia Road, Survey No. 3-22-4-11, established on September 7, 1965, lying west of the 84-foot right-of-way of the present alignment. The vacation area, in addition to the area known as that portion of Orillia Road Extension, Survey No. 35-23-4-3, contains an excess of land, purchased as right-of-way, in a \$4,300 Quit Claim Deed recorded in volume 4776 of Deeds, page 73. Prior to the new alignment, the County maintained the older road for many years. The vacation would be classified "A Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759. King County is now in receipt of \$2,148.00 from the petitioner which has been judged to be the just compensation to King County for this vacation area.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the subject vacation area useless as part of the County road system and believe that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
