



1           Effective January 1, 1978, the Basic Monthly Parking Rate  
2 shall be \$15.00/month.

3           Effective January 1, 1979, the Basic Monthly Parking Rate  
4 shall be established by the following method. No more than 90  
5 days prior to January 1 of each calendar year, the Department of  
6 Executive Administration shall conduct a survey of the monthly  
7 parking rates charged for public parking in all lots of 10 or  
8 more spaces within the area bounded by Jackson Street on the  
9 South, 6th Avenue on the East, Columbia Street on the North, and  
10 2nd Avenue on the West. The simple average of these rates,  
11 rounded to the nearest whole dollar, shall be the Basic Monthly  
12 Parking Rate for the subsequent calendar year. All revenues  
13 derived from parking fees shall be used to pay (1) operating  
14 expenses, and (2) bond retirement for the garage.

15           SECTION 4. Exemptions. King County Motor Pool vehicles not  
16 assigned to individuals are exempt from the provisions of Section  
17 3 of this ordinance, provided that this exemption shall expire  
18 December 31, 1978, and the implementing plan to charge Motor Pool  
19 vehicles will be presented to the Council by July 1, 1978.

20           SECTION 5. Public Parking Area. Parking space will be  
21 established for public parking without charge to be used in  
22 connection with county business. Public parking shall be limited  
23 to two hours. Exceptions may be made if they meet explicit  
24 criteria for exemption established by the King County Adminis-  
25 trative Officer and monitored by the King County Auditor.

26           SECTION 6. Parking Assignments.

- 27           1. Employees and positions currently assigned stalls for  
28 the purpose of private parking within the Automotive  
29 Center and the King County Courthouse will retain a  
30 parking space subject to payment of fees as specified  
31 in Section 3.

1           2. Spaces will be reserved for the ambulatory handicapped  
2           and located convenient to elevators.

3           SECTION 7. Penalites. The County Administrative Officer  
4           or his/her designee is authorized to issue overtime parking  
5           citations and to impound vehicles found to be in violation of  
6           any of the provisions of this ordinance or the regulations  
7           promulgated thereunder. The County Administrative Officer or  
8           his/her designee may rescind the parking privilege of persons  
9           found to be in violation of this ordinance or the regulations  
10          promulgated thereunder.
