ORDINANCE NO. 3519

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Annexation #49 to Northeast Lake Washington Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Annexation #49 to Northeast Lake Washington Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective November 10, 1977.

2. Northeast Lake Washington District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 77-9-4, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Northeast Lake Washington Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated October 21, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1977, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Northeast Lake Washington Sewer District of the area known as Annexation #49 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Annexation #49 to be annexed is described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 28, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington;

Thence N 01° 28' 01" E along the east line thereof, 665.43 feet to the True Point of Beginning;

Thence S 88° 24' 59" W, 164.49 feet;

Thence N 88° 26' 13" W, 636.86 feet, more or less, to the easterly margin of Slater Avenue NE;

Thence continue N 88° 26' 13" W to the centerline of Slater Avenue NE;

Thence northeasterly along the centerline of Slater Avenue NE to its intersection with a line which is 200 feet north of and parallel to the south line of the N  $\frac{1}{2}$  of said SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ;

5 Thence south along said east line, 197.91 feet to the
