ORDINANCE NO. 3523

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$135,000 to the Arterial Highway Development Fund for the construction projects known as Glendale Way South (607571), revising the 1977 Capital Improvement Program and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$135,000 from the unencumbered fund balance in the Arterial Highway Development Fund to complete construction of Glendale Way South (607571).

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

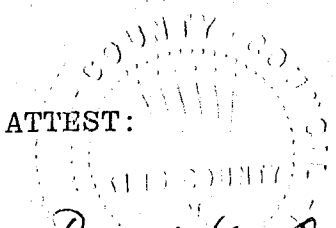
