ORDINANCE NO. 3531

AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, establishing a passenger curb loading zone on the south side of South 312th Street west of 6th Avenue South, and amending King County Ordinance 1100, Schedule 19.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, and as authorized by KCC 46.61.575-4 adopting RCW 46.61.575, Schedule 19 of the King County Traffic Code which establishes passenger curb loading zones along county roads is amended to add the following location:

SOUTH 312TH STREET, on the south side beginning at a point 100 feet west of the centerline of 6th Avenue South, thence westerly for 80 feet.

SECTION 2. Signs to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority.
