ORDINANCE NO. 3545

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$200,974 to the Grant Fund for Youth Community Conservation and Improvement Projects and declaring it an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$200,974 is hereby appropriated to the Grant Fund from the Department of Labor through the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium for the following Youth Community Conservation and Improvement Projects.

- a) Mercer Island Childrens' Safety Town \$45,101
- b) Fircrest and Firlands Site Development 28,705  
and Sculpture
- c) County Parks Improvements 90,235
- d) Enumclaw Schools Painting Project 36,933

SECTION II. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for support of county government and its existing public institutions.
