ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Fairwood Point to King County Water District No. 58.

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Fairwood Point to King County Water District No. 58 was filed with the County Council effective December 5, 1977.
