ORDINANCE NO. 3551

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Fairwood Point to King County Water District No. 58.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Fairwood Point to King County Water District No. 58 was filed with the County Council effective December 5, 1977.
2. King County Water District No. 58 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 1630, concurred with the proposed annexation.
3. King County Water District No. 58 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated September 13, 1977, on the proposed annexation.
4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 3rd day of January, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 58 of the area known as Fairwood Point and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
