ORDINANCE NO. **3554**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Public Health Department; fixing charges for family planning supplies at cost plus tax; and amending Ordinance 2596, Section 2, and King County Code 2.24.150.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2596, Section 2, and King County Code 2.24.150 are hereby amended as follows:

a) The director of the Department of Public Health is authorized and directed to make a charge for the provision of family planning services and supplies. These services can include, but are not limited to, a physical examination, urine examination, hematocrit, and birth control consultation.

b) The fee charged is as follows:
