BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Resolution 15311, Section 2 and K.C.C. 13.20.020 are hereby amended as follows:

Fee for Report. Application for a report on such water supply or individual sewage disposal system shall be accompanied by a fee ((in-the-amount-of-forty-dollars-for-each-such-individual-request, provided-however; when-an-application-for-a-report-is-made-for both-the-water-supply-and-sewage-system-on-the-same-premises-at the-same-time; only-one-fee-will-be-charged;) as follows:

For a report on a water supply\$25.00

For a report on a sewage disposal system.....\$40.00

For a report on a water supply and a sewage

disposal system on the same premises.....\$45.00

SECTION 2. Ordinance 3054 Section 3, and K.C.C. 13.20.030 are hereby amended as follows:

Submittal of water samples for analysis - Fee. Any ({public water-supply-purveyor-as-defined-in-WAE-248-54-260}) person, agency or company may submit water samples to the Department of Public Health for analysis. The fee for each water sample ({shall-be}) is six dollars.
