ORDINANCE NO. 3562

AN ORDINANCE relating to setting a date of election for annexation of territory to Lakehaven Sewer District known as Rustic Village II.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The proposed annexation of territory known as Rustic Village II to Lakehaven Sewer District will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience and will be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 2. A special election shall be held on March 14, 1978, within the territory of the proposed annexation as hereinafter described, between the hours of 7 A.M. and 8 P.M., for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors within the territory proposed to be annexed the proposition of annexing said territory to Lakehaven Sewer District.

SECTION 3. The boundaries of the territory to be annexed to Lakehaven Sewer District are hereby described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the South line of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington (said line also being the centerline of South 288th Street) and the Southerly prolongation of the Westerly line of the plat of Rustic Village as recorded in Volume 65 of Plats, page 47 - 48, Records of King County, Washington;

Thence Northerly along said Westerly line and its Southerly prolongation to an intersection with the Southerly line of the plat of Noffsingers Second Addition as recorded in Volume 75 of Plats, page 93, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Westerly along said South line and its Westerly prolongation to an intersection with the centerline of Military Road;

Thence Northeasterly along said centerline of Military Road to its intersection with the East margin of Interstate Highway No. 5;

Thence Southerly along the East margin of said Interstate Highway No. 5 to its intersection with the East line of said Section 33 (also being the West line of Section 34)

2 to the Southeast corner thereof;

3 Thence Westerly along the South line of said Section 33
4 (also being the centerline of South 288th Street) to
5 the Point of Beginning.

6 LESS the following described parcel:

7 The West half of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast
8 quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 33,
9 Township 22 North, Range 4 East W.M., King County,
10 Washington;

11 AND LESS the West 138 feet of the South 316 feet
12 thereof;

13 AND LESS the North 120 feet thereof.

14 SECTION 4. In submitting said proposition to the voters for
15 their approval or rejection, the proposition shall be expressed
16 on the ballot in the following terms:

17 For Annexation to Lakehaven Sewer District

18 Against Annexation to Lakehaven Sewer District

19 SECTION 5. Notice of election shall be published as
20 required by law.
