ORDINANCE NO. 3564

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of an old county road near Novelty Hill Road Petitioner: King County for Covenant Properties West V-1481

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A request for vacation of an old county road at the intersection of Novelty Hill and Avondale roads, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and were advised that utilities are not affected.
- 4. The owners of the adjoining lands, Covenant Properties West, have conveyed 12,800 square feet of right of way for Novelty Hill and Avondale roads conditioned on the vacation of the old alignment as described herein comprising 4,650 square feet.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believe that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due Notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the /6th day of January, 1978.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said vacation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KING:

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The Council on the // day of January, 1978 1 hereby vacates and abandons the portion of the old county road, 2 3 described as follows: All that portion of old county road, said old county road lying in Government Lot 3 in 5 Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M., lying adjacent to and SEly of a line 6 50 ft. SEly of and parallel to the centerline of Avondale Road as surveyed by King County Road Survey No. 12-25-5-1 and lying Nly of a line 30 ft. Nly of and parallel to that part 8 of the centerline of Novelty Hill Road described as follows: Beginning at Engr's Sta. 6+53.65 on the centerline of Novelty Hill 10 Road as surveyed by King County Road Survey No. 6-25-6-6; thence NWly along a curve to 11 the right, having a radius of 159 feet thru a 12 central angle of 72°23'26"; an arc distance of 200.89 feet; said curve being tangent at 13 said Engr's Sta. 6+53.65; thence North 68° 51'57" West to a point of intersection with 14 said centerline of Avondale Road.
