ORDINANCE NO. 3565

AN ORDINANCE authorizing condemnation of certain property for Sammamish River Park.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. The Board of County Commissioners of King County, by Resolution No. 34571, dated December 18, 1967, found and declared that it is necessary for the public welfare and the benefit of the residents of King County that a site be acquired in King County for Sammamish River Park.
- 2. The voters of King County on February 13, 1968, authorized the issuance of General Obligation Bonds to acquire and construct public parks and recreation facilities within King County.
- 3. The Board of County Commissioners had, by Resolution No. 29912, adopted a Ten Year Program for Open Space Acquisition, and by Resolution No. 35155, dated April 8, 1968, the Board did amend said program to include all Forward Thrust acquisition proposals contained in Resolution No. 34571.
- 4. In order to implement said Amended Acquisition Plan, the King County Parks Division prepared and submitted a Capital Improvement Program, and on December 10, 1968, by Resolution No. 36420, the Board approved said Improvement Program and authorized the Parks Division to proceed with its implementation.
- 5. The Capital Improvement Program provides for the acquisition and construction of Sammamish River Park.
- 6. Negotiations to acquire the subject property by purchase has proved unsuccessful and it is therefore necessary that King County acquire this property by condemnation.
- 7. The King County Council finds that the public health and welfare demand the acquisition and construction of Sammamish River Park in accordance with the Capital Improvement Program, and that certain property and property rights be condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged as provided in this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Council has deemed it necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County that the lands herein

described, and other property rights and/or rights in property be condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for the purpose of constructing and improving the Sammamish River Park, subject to the making or paying of just compensation to the owner thereof in the manner provided by law.

PARCEL I - PATCHETT/HARNECKER

Commencing at the East 1/4 corner of Section 11, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; thence North 56°14'02" West 1,877.18 ft. to the intersection of the northwesterly margin of State Aid Road No. 56 (Leary Way) and the southwesterly margin of the Sammamish River right of way and the true point of beginning; thence South 46°14'28" West along the northwesterly margin of Leary Way, a distance of 60 ft.; thence North 43°45'32" West 125.16 ft.; thence along a curve to the right, the center of which bears South 05°02'35" West, having a radius of 258.3 ft., and an arc length of 140.52 ft. to the point of beginning.

PARCEL II - INTERCHANGE ASSOCIATES, a limited partnership

That portion of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 in Section 9, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., lying northerly of the centerline of the Sammamish River Channel, and being southerly of Line No. 2 hereinafter described, and as shown on map of Primary State Highway No. 2 (SR 522) recorded in Volume 3 of Highway Plats on pages 161 and 162, under Auditor's File No. 6014779, records of King County, Washington.

LINE NO. 2 - Beginning at a point 130 ft. distant southerly when measured at right angles from said PSH No. 2 Line Survey at Station PSH 2 194+00; thence southwesterly and westerly along a line which is 86 ft. distant northerly when measured at right angles and/or radially from the Sammamish River Channel centerline survey, all as shown on map recorded in Volume 3 of Highway Plats on pages 161 and 162, under Auditor's File No. 6014779, records of King County, Washington to an intersection with Line No. 1, as designated on said map (being the southerly right of way margin of PSH No. 2 (SR 522); EXCEPT that portion lying within the margins of PSH No. 2.

PARCEL III - BURLINGTON NORTHERN RAILROAD

- <u>A</u> (Seattle Belt Line) That portion of the Northern Pacific Railroad right of way, Seattle Belt Line, in Section 9, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., lying northeasterly of the Sammamish River and southwesterly of a line which is parallel and concentric with the centerline of the Sammamish River and 70 ft. northeasterly therefrom.
- \underline{B} (Sumas Branch) That portion of the Northern Pacific Railway right of way, Sumas Branch, in Section 9, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., lying northeasterly of the Sammamish River and southwesterly of a line which is parallel and concentric with the centerline of the Sammamish River and 90 ft. northeasterly therefrom.
- \underline{C} (North Bend Branch) That portion of the Northern Pacific Railway right of way, North Bend Branch, in Sections 2 and 11, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., lying easterly of the Sammamish River and westerly of a line which is parallel and

PARCEL V - BOTHELL STATION DEVELOPMENT GROUP A permanent easement for a recreational trail bridge, and public trail 10 ft. in total width, and a temporary construction easement 20 ft. in total width, over and across tax lot Nos. 7, 8, and 54, located in the North 1/2 of 10 Section 8, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington. The location of said trail shall be 11 within the boundaries as described in the following river protection easements recorded with King County: Tax Lots 12 7 and 54, Auditor's File No. 5662041, dated October 22, 1963, Volume 4472, Page 624. Tax Lot 8, Auditor's File 13 No. 5441954, dated May 12, 1962, Volume 4288, page 619. 14 SECTION 2. The King County Council determines that condemnation pro-15 ceedings are hereby authorized to acquire property and property rights 16 and/or rights in property for the subject park project. 17 SECTION 3.
