ORDINANCE NO. 3572

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of an alley in Block 1, Head's 1/4 Acre Tracts V-1570 Petitioner: King County

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A request has been received for vacation of a portion of an alley in Block 1, Head's 1/4 Acre Tracts, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. This vacation area is in connection with the construction of a Police and Justice Court building.
- 4. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and were advised that easements are not required.
- 5. The portion of Block 1, Head's 1/4 Acre Tracts described in this vacation is a 16-foot wide alley which was recorded in the County records on July 1, 1919, and lies west of 6th Avenue SW and between SW 148th Street and SW 149th Street. There is no record that the portion of alley 179.49 feet in length has ever been open. The vacation would be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 6. The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the
