## ORDINANCE NO. 3573

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 138th Avenue S.E. V-1563 Petitioner: King County Library System

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A request has been received for vacation of a portion of 138th Avenue S.E., hereinafter described.
- 2. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and were advised that Washington Natural Gas Company apparently has existing gas lines in the area.
- 4. The portion of 138th Avenue S.E. described in this vacation was conveyed to King County by Quit-Claim Deed dated September 13, 1965. The Department of Public Works found no record that the County has ever spent funds to open or maintain this right of way. The right of way would, therefore, be classified "C Class" in accordance with Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the subject vacation area useless as part of the County road system and believe that the public would be benefited by vacation.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the  $23^{\circ}$  day of  $99^{\circ}$ .

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
SECTION 1. The Council on the 23 day of January, 1928,

hereby vacates and abandons the portion of 138th Avenue S.E., 1 2 described as follows: 3 All that portion of 138th Avenue S.E. lying Southerly of the South right-of-way margin of SE Allen Road and Northerly of the North right-of-way margin of SE Newport Way located in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, Vacation area contains approximately 11,100 square feet.
