ORDINANCE NO. 3577

AN ORDINANCE approving the water general comprehensive plan for King County Water District No. 81.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. King County Water District No. 81 submitted a water general comprehensive plan to King County for approval as required by RCW 57.16.010 and Chapter 13.24 KCC.

2. Water District No. 81 filed a Declaration of Environmental Non-Significance dated February 7, 1977 on the proposed plan.

3. In October, 1977, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan and by U.T.R.C. No. 77-13 dated October 13, 1977, recommended approval.

4. That portion of the proposed Water District No. 81 service area which is north of the City of Redmond and east of Willows Road is designated for agricultural use in the Northshore Communities Plan, Ordinance 3325.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Water District No. 81 general comprehensive plan entitled "Comprehensive Plan" February 1977, attached as Exhibit A, and amended by Section 2 of this ordinance, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That portion of the proposed Water District No. 81 service area which is north of the City of Redmond and east of Willows Road is not approved for service.

SECTION 3. No right-of-way construction permits for construction of water facilities shall be issued to Water District No. 81 or within Water District No. 81 unless the Division of Real Property receives certification from the Division of Building and Land Development that such construction is consistent with the comprehensive plan approved herein and this ordinance.

1            SECTION 4. This approval shall remain in effect for a  
 2 period of five years from the effective date of this ordinance,  
 3 except that any water facilities constructed or under contract  
 4 for construction prior to the expiration of this approval shall  
 5 not require further approval. Prior to the expiration of this  
 6 approval, the District must submit a revised and updated plan  
 7 for those facilities not then under contract.
