## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of an area known as Meredith from Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective December 13, 1977.
- 2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for withdrawal to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 77-546, concurred with the proposed withdrawal.
- 3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated November 1, 1977, on the proposed withdrawal.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 30th day of fanceary, 19 78, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

SECTION 1. The withdrawal by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as Meredith and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Meredith to be withdrawn is described as follows:
