ORDINANCE NO. 3596

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$26,500 to the River & Flood Control Construction Fund, with \$13,250 of this amount to come from unappropriated River & Flood Control Fund balance and \$13,250 to come as additional revenue from the City of Seattle. These funds to be used for a flood early warning system on the Tolt River; amending the King County 1978 Capital Improvement Budget and amending Ordinance No. 3492, Section 73 and Section 72, Attachment No. 1.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$26,500 to the River & Flood Control Construction Fund, with \$13,250 of this amount to come from unappropriated River & Flood Control Fund Balance and \$13,250 to come as additional revenue from the City of Seattle. These funds to be used for a flood early warning system on the Tolt River, Capital Improvement Project No. 046274.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3492, Section 73, is hereby amended to read as follows:

PROVIDED THAT:


All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 3492, Section 73 shall be fulfilled.





Tolt River Dam Alarm System.

This project is for installation of equipment to provide monitoring and alarm systems for the South Fork Tolt River downstream from the Seattle Water Department Tolt River Water Supply earth-filled dam. Purpose of these systems is to provide sufficient warning to downstream residents, should any weakness or failure occur in the dam.

Equipment will include telemetry to monitor the USGS gage downstream of the dam and an area where recurrent slides have occurred, and an alarm system to provide backup and verification for the telemetering device.

Seattle Water Department will participate in funding this project in the amount of 50 percent of the cost.
