AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Engineer's Investment Trust to King County Water District No. 119.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Engineer's Investment Trust to King County Water District No. 119 was filed with the County Council effective October 28, 1977.
- 2. King County Water District No. 119 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolutions 68 and 69, concurred with the proposed annexation.
- King County Water District No. 119 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated September 9, 1977, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 28th day of househous, 1977, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 119 of the area known as Engineer's Investment Trust and described in Section 2 herein is approved. PROVIDED that, any water service provided within the annexation area shall not be inconsistent with Water District No. 119's water comprehensive plan to be approved in accordance with RCW 56.08.020 and K.C.C. 13.24.
