ORDINANCE NO. 3621

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Four Corners to King County Water District No. 105.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Four Corners to King County Water District No. 105 was filed with the County Council effective January 19, 1978.

2. King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 514, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 105 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated November 7, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 14~~th~~ day of February, 1978, and has considered the ~~criteria~~ set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Four Corners and described in Section 2 herein is approved. PROVIDED that, any water service provided within the annexation area shall not be inconsistent with Water District No. 105's water comprehensive plan to be approved in accordance with RCW 56.08.020 and KCC 13.24.
