ORDINANCE NO. 3 6 2 4

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$14,000 to Civil Service from the Executive Contingency of Special Programs for the purpose of providing recruit training, amending Ordinance No. 3492, Sections 27 and 41, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$14,000 from the Executive Contingency of Special Programs to Civil Service is hereby approved and adopted for the purpose of providing additional training and testing of police recruits.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3492, Section 27 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Civil Service ((~~\$70,196~~)) \$ 84,196

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 3492, Section 41, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs ((~~\$5,888,237~~)) \$5,874,237

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of ((~~\$127,084~~)) \$113,084 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests that the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.

PROVIDED THAT:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 3492, Section 40, as amended shall be fulfilled.
