ORDINANCE NO. 3634

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the traffic code;
2 prohibiting parking during specified hours
3 directly adjacent to curbside post office
4 boxes; amending Ordinance 1100, Section 1,
5 and KCC 46.61.570.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 1100, Section 1, and KCC 46.61.570, is
8 hereby amended to read as follows:

9 Stopping, standing or parking prohibited in specified
10 places. (1) Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other
11 traffic, or in compliance with law or the directions of a police
12 officer or official traffic-control device, no person shall:

13 (a) Stop, stand or park a vehicle:

14 (i) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or
15 parked at the edge or curb of a street;

16 (ii) On a sidewalk or street planting strip;

17 (iii) Within an intersection;

18 (iv) On a crosswalk;

19 (v) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb
20 or within thirty feet of points on the curb immediately opposite
21 the ends of a safety zone, unless official signs or markings
22 indicate a different no-parking area opposite the ends of a
23 safety zone;

24 (vi) Alongside or opposite any street excavation
25 or obstruction when stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct
26 traffic;

27 (vii) Upon any bridge or other elevated structure
28 upon a highway or within a highway tunnel;

29 (viii) On any railroad tracks; or

30 (ix) At any place where official signs prohibit
31 stopping:

32 (x) Directly adjacent to curbside, clearly
33 visible, residential mail boxes between 10:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M.
on all days of scheduled mail delivery by the United States
Postal Service.

1 (b) Stand or park a vehicle, whether occupied or not,
2 except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger or
3 passengers:

4 (i) In front of a public or private driveway or
5 within five feet of the end of the curb radius leading thereto;

6 (ii) Within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant;

7 (iii) Within twenty feet of a crosswalk;

8 (iv) Within thirty feet upon the approach to any
9 flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign, or traffic-control
10 signal located at the side of a roadway;

11 (v) Within twenty feet of the driveway entrance
12 to any fire station and on the side of a street opposite the
13 entrance to any fire station within seventy-five feet of said
14 entrance; or

15 (vi) At any place where official signs prohibit
16 standing.

17 (c) Park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except
18 temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in
19 loading or unloading merchandise or passengers;

20 (i) Within fifty feet of the nearest rail of a
21 railroad crossing; or

22 (ii) At any place where official signs prohibit
23 parking.

24 (2) Parking or standing shall be permitted in the manner pro-
25 vided by law at all other places except a time limit may be imposed
26 or parking restricted at other places.

27 (3) No person shall move vehicle not lawfully under his
28 control into any such prohibited area or away from a curb such a
