ORDINANCE NO. 3653

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as P-254 to Cascade Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as P-254 to Cascade Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective February 23, 1978.
2. Cascade Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 744, concurred with the proposed annexation.
3. Cascade Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated September 15, 1977, on the proposed annexation.
4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 3rd day of April, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cascade Sewer District of the area known as P-254 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as P-254 to be annexed is

described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the North line of Section 7, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M. with the West line of the East quarter thereof;

Said point being on the existing boundary of Cascade Sewer District;

Thence Southerly along said West line to the South line of the North quarter of said Section 7;

Thence Westerly along said South line to the Easterly margin of State Highway No. 167;

Thence Northerly along said Easterly margin to the North line of said Section 7;

Thence Easterly along said North line to the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of said Section 7;

Thence Southerly along the West line of said Northeast quarter to an intersection with the centerline of South 208th St.;

Thence Easterly along said centerline to an intersection with the North line of said Section 7;

Thence Easterly along said North line to the Point of Beginning.
