ORDINANCE NO. 3656

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 144th Place Southeast to King County Water District No. 107.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as 144th Place Southeast to King County Water District was filed with the County Council effective February 23, 1978.
2. King County Water District No. 107 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 422, concurred with the proposed annexation.
3. King County Water District No. 107 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated January 25, 1978, on the proposed annexation.
4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 3rd day of April, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 107 of the area known as 144th Place Southeast and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
