BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1438, Section 3(b) and KCC 2.50.050(4) are hereby amended to read as follows:

ARCHITECTURE DIVISION. The Architecture Division shall be responsible for the administration of the King County design commission, (~~shall administer all projects within the purview of the design commission, and shall administer all other projects assigned to it.~~) to include the recording and keeping of written minutes of all proceedings of the design commission, for the project management of capital improvements involving buildings or parks, for the providing of advisory services and/or feasibility studies of proposed capital improvement projects as approved by the Director of the Department of Planning and Community Development. 
