2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an
3 area known as Schembs to King County Water
4 District No. 82.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT:

6 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of
7 an area known as Schembs to King County Water District
8 No. 82 was filed with the County Council effective
9 March 7, 1978.

10 2. King County Water District No. 82 has found the
11 petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by
12 Resolutions 345 and 347, concurred with the proposed
13 annexation.

14 3. King County Water District No. 82 filed a
15 Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated November 2,
16 1977 on the proposed annexation.

17 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the
18 10th day of April, 1978, and has
19 considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

20 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

21 SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No.
22 82 of the area known as Schembs and described in Section 2 herein
23 is approved.
