ORDINANCE NO. 3674

AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control; prohibiting parking at all times on both sides of 21st Avenue Southwest between Dash Point Road (SR#509) and Southwest 356th Street, and providing proper signs and markings, amending King County Ordinance 1100, Schedule 14.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to requests by local residents and in the interest of public safety, King County Ordinance 1100, Schedule 14, which prohibits parking at all times along county roads is amended, as authorized by King County Traffic Code 46.61.570-5, to add the following location:

21st Avenue Southwest, on both sides between Dash Point Road (SR#509) and Southwest 356th Street.

SECTION 2. Signs and markings shall be provided to delineate 21st Avenue Southwest as a four lane facility between Dash Point Road (SR#509) and Southwest 356th Street.

SECTION 3. Signs and markings to evidence the above described restriction and delineation shall be installed by the proper authority.
