ORDINANCE NO. 3679

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as P-256RR to Cascade Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as P-256RR to Cascade Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective March 10, 1978.
- 2. Cascade Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 793, concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Cascade Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated February 16, 1978, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 10th day of April, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cascade Sewer District of the area known as P-256RR and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as P-256RR to be annexed is described as follows:

The South 135 feet of the East 326 feet of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M., in King County, Washington.
