AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation to the Park Acquisition and Development Fund in the amount of \$27,500 from the Community Development Block Grant Fund; establishing an economic development component; establishing a new block grant activity; reallocating block grant funds; and amending Ordinance No. 3492, Sections 52 and 73, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$27,500 to the Park Acquisition and Development Fund from the Community Development Block Grant Fund for the Ravendsdale Park (CD-767), Capital Improvement Project No. 070306.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved a reallocation in the amount of \$16,130 for community planning assistance for the cities of Duvall (\$8,065) and Enumclaw (\$8,065).

SECTION 3. CD-655-78, Planning Assistance, is hereby canceled and \$25,095 reallocated as follows:
