ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the District Court Plan; adding an additional judgeship to the Federal Way District Court; amending Ordinance No. 3714, Section 5 and Ordinance No. 2694, Section 10.

PREAMBLE:

Ordinance No. 3714 will become effective January 13, 1979. Currently the legality of Ordinance No. 3714 is an issue on appeal to the Washington State Supreme Court. In the event Ordinance No. 3714 is declared invalid, Ordinance No. 2694 will be the County District Court Plan.

BE IT OPDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 3714, Section 5, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Name of the Court: The Justice Court of the State of Washington in and for Federal Way District, County of King, organized as follows:

- 1. Name of the justice court district: Federal Way District.
 - 2. Population: ((58, 900)) 64,300
- 3. Number of justices to be elected: ((Θ ne)) Two full-time justices.
- 4. Location of central office, courtroom and records: In the vicinity of Federal Way.
- 5. Location of other courtrooms: None (except as provided by other cities for hearing violations of municipal ordinances).
- 6. Number and location of justice court commissioners to be authorized: One justice court commissioner at the central office, together with such additional court commissioners as the district justice may require.
- 7. The departments into which the justice court shall be organized initially, including municipal departments: None, pending future amendment of the plan.
- 8. The allocation of time and salary, if any, of any justice who shall serve part-time in the municipal department:

 None, pending future amendment of the plan.

Name of the Court: The Justice of Court of the State of Washington in and for Southwest District, County of King, organized as follows:

- 1. Name of the justice court district: Southwest District.
- 2. Population: ((58, 999)) 64,300
- 3. Number of justices to be elected: ((Θ ne)) $\underline{\text{Two}}$ full-time justices.
- 4. Location of central office, courtroom and records: In the vicinity of Federal Way.
- 5. Location of other courtrooms: None (except as provided by other cities for hearing violations of municipal ordinances).
- 6. Number and location of justice court commissioners to be authorized: One justice court commissioner at the central office, together with such additional court commissioners as the district justice may require.
