## ORDINANCE NO. 3761

AN ORDINANCE relating to the designation of certain agricultural lands in King County and amending Ordinance No. 3064, Attachments Al, A2, B, D, E and F.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 3064, Attachments Al, A2, B, D and E are hereby amended to include lands containing Class IV through Class VIII soils which are an integral part of an existing commercial farm operation.

Attachment F is further amended to read as follows:

#### ATTACHMENT F

### CRITERIA FOR IDENTIFICATION OF AGRICULTURAL LANDS OF COUNTY SIG- " NIFICANCE

Within King County Agricultural Districts only lands which do not meet all of the following criteria shall be designated as Agricultural Lands of County Significance:

- 1. Lands containing Class IV through Class VIII soils except for those lands ((containing-Class-IV-soils-currently-being farmed-and-contiguous-to-Class-II-&-III-soils;)) containing Class IV through VIII soils which are an integral part of an existing commercial farm operation; and
- Wooded lands lands that contain established brush or tree 2. cover or swampland as of July 1976; and
- Lands in urban uses Lands containing Class II and III soils 3. which have been developed and/or covered by fill material since the SCS 1972 soils survey. This criterion includes golf courses and parks, if developed and in use; and
- Lands which have urban level sewer and/or water lines in 4. place and where either:
  - indebtedness has been incurred by abutting property owners, or

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
